National Alliance on Mental Illness - DE	NAMI-DE is a 35 year old non-profit organization who have been helping to improve the lives of the Mentally Ill in Delaware. http://www.namidelaware.org/ We offer Education (free programs, seminars and presentations to increase the understanding of mental illness, causes and recovery. Focused educational programs for people living with mental illness, and their family members. We just started Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Training to improve police response to people in mental health crisis, to divert people with mental illness from the criminal justice system and to improve outcomes of these encounters. We offer free Support Group meetings every month in all 3 counties of Delaware. Also, we provide HelpLine services that provide support, information, referrals, resources and recommendations via telephone, email and office walk-ins during business hours. We provide Advocacy for the Mentally Ill. By programs and presentations to erase stigma and discrimination associated with mental illness. Collaborations with others and policy makers to analyze and recommend policy changes. We provide Housing for over 250 chronic mentally ill persons in our 60 houses in all three Delaware counties.
