

Who is eligible for a booster?



Eligibility for a booster is dependent on the age of the person and the date of their last vaccination. We ask that everyone keep their vaccination status up to date including boosters when eligible.

U.S. guidelines say any adult who received two Pfizer or Moderna vaccinations is eligible for a booster five months after their last shot. The Johnson & Johnson booster interval is two months. Adults over age 50 or people with high risk conditions are eligible for a second booster shot. Check with your doctor to determine timing and if you should have a second booster.

Adolescents aged 12 to 17 years old can receive a booster shot 5 months after their initial Pfizer-BioNTech vaccination series.

Parents and caregivers can now get their children 6 months through 5 years of age vaccinated with the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines to better protect them from COVID-19. All children, including children who have already had COVID-19, should get vaccinated. Children aged 5 and up may also be eligible for boosters, check with your doctor.
